JAVA and Oracle 12c - The good, better and best

The Oracle database language du jour is primarily pl/sql and SQL. However as many third party vendors create more shareware for software development it may become quite difficult to stay within the pl/sql SQL mix. JAVA, on the scene since 1978 has become the language that is used quite extensively in Oracle developmental database as well as third party software.
